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| | <p>DAY 01: Manila Arrive Manila. Met upon arrival and transfer to Diamond Hotel. The hotel is located on Manila Bay that offers beautiful sunsets. If time allows, the major cultural spot to visit in Manila is Intramuros: walking distance from the hotel. You can discover the old Spanish walled city with its remnants of colonial times: San Agustin Church and Museum, Manila Cathedral, Casa Manila and many old Spanish houses, and of course, Fort Santiago, the Spanish fortress by the river. Overnight Diamond Hotel.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 02: Manila – Flower Island (B/L/D) (bungalow with fan) Breakfast Diamond Hotel. Transfer to domestic airport in time for Flight with Asian Spirit on a small aircraft from Manila to Taytay. There are beautiful views of the islands when flying over including famous Taal Volcano, South of Manila: a volcano with a lake within a volcano. On arrival transfer to river inlet then by private boat to private Flower Island (30 minutes). Flower Island greets you with a beautiful south sea white sandy beach. Lunch, dinner and overnight on Flower Island resort.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 03 to DAY 06: Flower Island (B/L/D) Spend the day at your leisure, swimming, snorkelling, island hopping, fishing, volley ball, boules, badminton, etc... A visit to the nearby Pearl Farm can take place any day before departure. Overnight on Flower Island resort in a thatched cottage on the beach.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 07: Flower Island – El Nido (B/L/D) Transfer to El Nido (boat back to Taytay airport and minivan to El Nido (approx. 2hrs. by hard pack road through rural scenery and tropical wilderness where numerous white herons and other birds can be spotted along the way) and then by boat to Miniloc Island Resort, El Nido. Lunch, dinner and overnight on the island.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 08 to DAY 11: Miniloc Island, El Nido (B/L/D) At leisure to pursue water sports activities including kayaking and other non-motorized marine sports (windsurf, hobiecat, etc... subject to availability), snorkelling, island hopping, exploration, fishing, visit the small and big lagoons, etc... Or simply sunbathing on the white sand beach. Guests are free to use all indoor recreational facilities. Overnight on the island.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 12: Miniloc Island, El Nido – Manila (B) Breakfast Miniloc. Transfer by outrigger boat to El Nido airport in time for Flight El Nido/Manila. Met on arrival and transferred to the Diamond Hotel for overnight stay and a last night back to civilization on the cosmopolitan city of Manila. DAY 13: Manila (B) Breakfast at Diamond Hotel before your transfer to the international airport and departure. Tour Ends.</p> |

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| | <p>DAY 01: Arrive Manila Arrive Manila. Met upon arrival and transfer to Diamond Hotel. The hotel is located on Manila Bay that offers beautiful sunsets. For those who are more into shopping, the nearby Robinson's Mall offers inexpensive shopping. For dinner, you can enjoy Manila nightlife around: the Manila Bay Walk offers a wide variety of restaurants and grills in a pleasant setting, and Malate district has plenty of lively bars and pubs...Overnight Diamond Hotel.</p> |
| | <p>DAY 02: Manila – Boracay Breakfast at the Diamond Hotel. Later transfer to Domestic airport for your flight Manila/Caticlan. Met on arrival and 10-minute transfer by land to the jetty for a 20-minute sea transfer by boat/outrigger to Boracay Island, disembarking on the main beach, with sometimes having to walk in knee-deep waters. In order that the natural beauty and environment are not spoilt, no jetty is allowed. Met on arrival and 5-minute land transfer to Boracay Hills Resort, on the southern part of the island. Overnight Boracay Hills (super deluxe room). Boracay Hills was voted 'One of the little gems of Asia 2006'</p> |

|  | DAY 03 to DAY6: Boracay Hills Breakfast. The day can be spent in the peace and quiet of the garden or exploring Boracay Island: this croissant-shaped island has a perfect white powdery sand beach on the west side ranked by several magazines among the top 10 beaches of the world. Overnight at Boracay Hills. The 4-kilometer strip along the main beach has everything for everyone and for all budgets: restaurants, bars, pubs, discos, massage parlours, shops, internet cafes, scuba diving centres, various seawater activities (kayaks, hobiecat, windsurf, banana boat, water ski, etc...). |
|  | DAY 07: Boracay Hills - Fridays Breakfast at Boracay Hills. 30-minute land transfer to the Northern part of the island and check in at Friday's Beach Resort. Overnight at Friday's (Deluxe Room). Friday's 4 star Resort at the other end of one of the most beautiful white sand beaches in the world. All activities can be enjoyed including swimming, snorkelling, diving, sandcastle building and within walking distance there are many bars, restaurants, shops and night entertainment. |
|  | DAY 08 to DAY 11: Fridays Beach Resort Breakfast. The day can be spent on the beach or taking part in water sports. Boracay has so much to offer and from that part of the beach, you can have a glimpse of the pulsating nightlife bustling towards the south. Overnight Friday's. DAY12: Fridays Beach Resort - Manila Breakfast Friday's. Later 30-minute transfer by sea to Caticlan jetty and by land to Caticlan airport for your flight Caticlan/Manila. NORTH LUZON + MINDORO, PHILIPPINES – MOUNTAIN PROVINCES AND PUERTO GALERA – 14 DAYS

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|  | DAY 01: Manila Arrive Manila. Met upon arrival and transfer to The Manila Hotel. |
|  | DAY 02: Manila – Baguio (B) Breakfast Manila Hotel. Departure by private car to Baguio, 7-8hrs ride through the plains of central Luzon, passing Tarlac where we can still see Lahar fields of the 1991 Pinatubo volcano eruption... Then up the mountains until Baguio, the city of Pines, or the summer capital of the Philippines. Overnight Camp John Hay Manor. |
|  | DAY 03: Baguio – Bontoc (B/L/D) Breakfast Camp John Hay Manor. Departure by private car to Bontoc, via the "Mountain Trail", the spectacular highest road point of the country (6-7 hours ride, with very stunning views of the cordillera...). Lunch en route. Check in at a local hotel in Bontoc. Visit Bontoc ethnological museum, for an excellent introduction about the different mountain tribes of the Philippines. Dinner and Overnight at the Hotel (Archog Hotel or similar). |
|  | DAY 04: Bontoc – Sagada - Banaue (B/L/D) After breakfast, morning tour to Sagada, a peaceful village up the mountain renowned for its burial caves... visit the burial caves, see the hanging coffins on the cliff, the weaving factory and the Masfere house (Masfere is a photographer who started taking pictures in the 30's... Back to Bontoc for lunch. In the afternoon, depart to Banaue (3hours ride) passing by the cloudy Mt Pulis saddle, with some of the most dramatic panoramas of all this road journey. We are now in the Ifugao territory, and check in at the Banaue Hotel for dinner and Overnight. The Ifugaos often refer to themselves as the builders of the original rice terraces: 4 villages around Banaue (Banaue, Batad, Bangaan and Mayoyao) are classified as UNESCO world heritage. We shall visit 3 of them. |
|  | DAY 05: Banaue - Batad (B/L/D) Breakfast Banaue Hotel. Departure by jeepney to the jump-off point for the trail to Batad: 1hr ride through the scenic Ifugao land, with rice terraces around... Trek to Batad (1h walk) and lunch at this typical Ifugao village, famous for its superb amphitheatre –style rice terraces, among the most beautiful in the region. ...Dinner and overnight in a local guest house in Batad (simple comfort). |
|  | DAY 06: Batad - Banaue (B/L/D) After breakfast, start trekking on the mountain crests trail from Batad to Bangaan (4hrs hike). Passing a few isolated village, this unforgettable walk offers some of the most beautiful views of the Ifugao cordillera...Lunch at a local restaurant in Bangaan.. Return jeepney to Banaue (1hr ride). Dinner and Overnight at the Banaue Hotel. |
|  | DAY 07: Banaue – Manila (B) Breakfast Banaue Hotel. Departure by private car back to Manila (9 – 10 hrs ride), going down the Cordillera, and through the Cagayan valley and the Sierra Madre, before again reaching the plains of central Luzon . Overnight Manila Hotel |
| | DAY 08: Manila – Puerto Galera (B) Breakfast Manila Hotel. Departure to Puerto Galera: 2h by land to Batangas pier and then 1h30 by boat from Batangas to Puerto Galera, Mindoro island.. Overnight Coco beach. The population is concentrated along the coast of Mindoro, one of the least developed of the big islands. The Mangyans tribes live in the interior where the tamaraw, the last remaining wild buffalos of the Philippines, are also found. Puerto Galera, on the northern coast, is a beautiful natural harbour - used as a typhoon shelter by Spanish Galleons during colonial times - is a protected natural marine reserve, famous for some of the most beautifully preserved corals in the country. |
| | DAY 08 to Day 11: Puerto Galera (B) Days free to discover Puerto Galera: Breakfast + overnight Coco beach. |
| | DAY 12: Puerto Galera – Manila (B) Breakfast Coco beach. Transfer back to Manila by shuttle (1h30 by boat + 2h by land). Evening free in Manila , and |



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| | Overnight at the Manila Hotel for a last night back to civilization on the cosmopolitan city of Manila. DAY 13: Manila (B) Breakfast at Manila Hotel before your transfer to the international airport and departure. Tour Ends |
